St.Patricks day

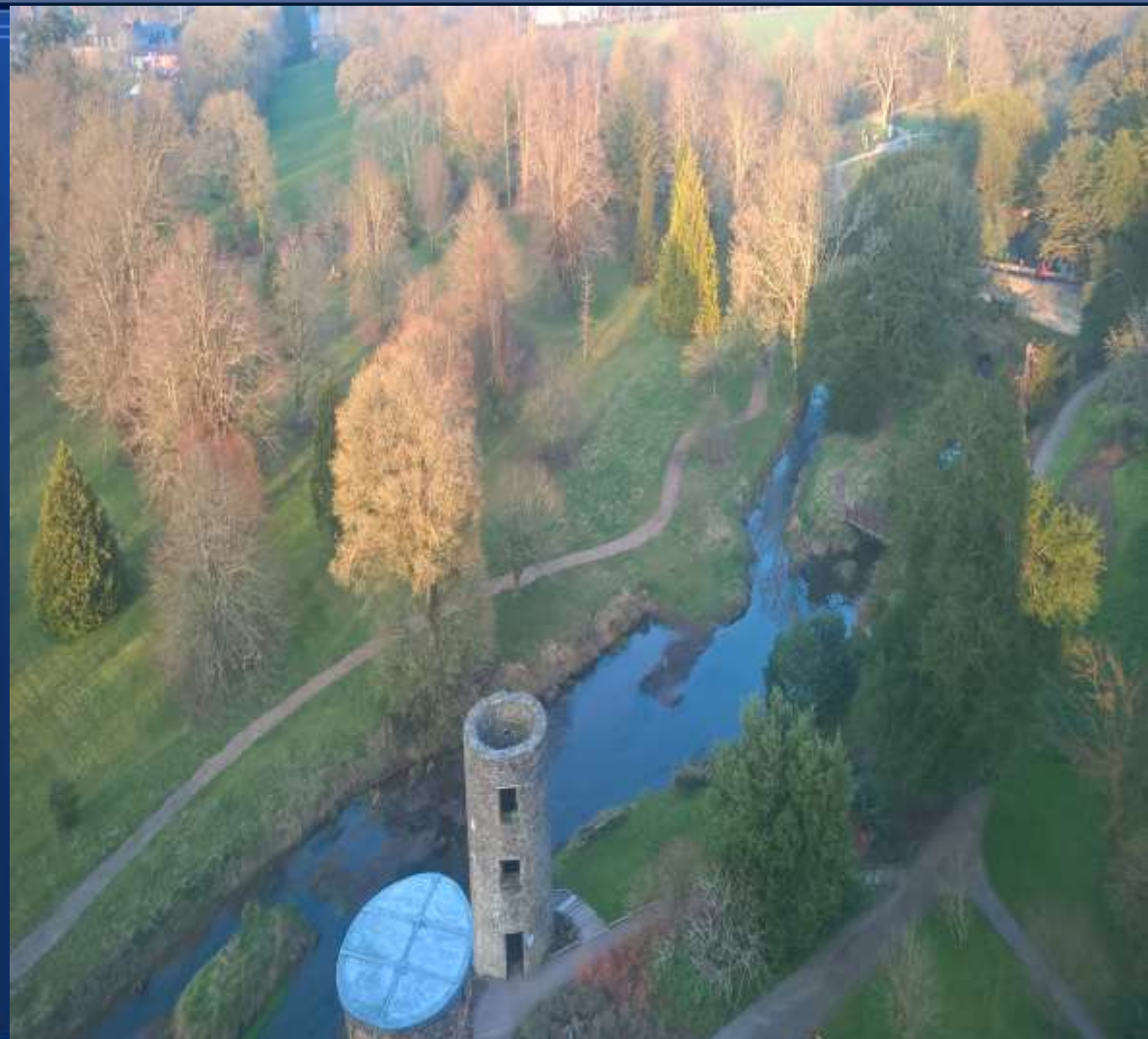
- On St. Patricks day we went to Cork City to see the wonderful Parade. Everybody wore green clothes and we too.
